God's *natural*, creative plan for marriage: Free, Faithful, Fruitful and Total

ove is nothing less than the complete gift of self—a free, faithful, fruitful, and total love. It is the love of God revealed in Jesus Christ, the love that exists within the three persons of the Trinity – each person giving themselves to each other so completely that they are One God. As human beings made in the image and likeness of God, we are called to imitate this selfless love in all of our relationships with one another, but most especially in the Sacrament of Marriage.

The grace of the sacrament gives to those who enter into it an incredible gift and privilege – the ability to cooperate with God in His creative power. Marital love, with its origin in God, is not restricted to a love that grows simply between spouses, but is intended to bring about new life.

There are only three instances when one can say there is a body in another body. The first is when we receive Holy Communion - we celebrate the union of our soul with Jesus Christ Himself in the Eucharist. The second is the conjugal union of husband and wife, and the third is a child in the womb.

Through God's revelation of His unique plan for those who enter into this incredible union, we now understand that the marital embrace is also meant to be profoundly holy - an outward, visible sign of the sacrament that it is.

"Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh."

Why is the Catholic Church against artificial Contraception?

The use of artificial contraception and sterilization degrades the human person. It violates the marriage vows and the sacramentality of marriage, as well as the natural purpose of human sexuality. The Church does not accept artificial contraception as a moral way in which to plan a family because it separates the unitive (love) and procreative (life) aspects of the marital act, which results in the destruction of both.

Contraception also disregards the sanctity, or holiness, of marriage. Using contraception is not only physically harmful to a woman's body, it is also harmful to the sacred relationship between spouses. Instead of building communication and mutual respect between them, it objectifies both.

Natural Family Planning

Natural Family Planning (NFP) is an umbrella term used for certain methods through which a couple may either achieve or avoid pregnancy through natural means. It is based upon the couple's own knowledge of the women's naturally occurring cycle of fertility and infertility. Natural Family Planning is not contraceptive; it is true family planning. When spouses conceive new life, they participate in God's creative and life-giving power - an incredible privilege and sacred responsibility.
